KATHY McGEE

Flint Powers Catholic High School



For the past 25 years, Kathy McGee has coached the Girls' Varsity basketball team at Flint Powers Catholic. Over the period of time, her teams have won 501 games with only losing 127. The 501 games won is a Girl's State record. More outstanding, since 1986, she has lost only 32 games; so you see coaches, it does take some time to develop a program. How have her teams done League and State Tournament wise? Flint Powers has had 15 League Championships (12 in a row); 15 District Championships (14 in a row -- a State record); 12 Regional titles (9 in a row -- a State record) and 4 State Championships in 1991, 1996, 2000 and 2001. Her team was 28-0 in 2001. Did we mention her teams were runners-up 3 times?

Kathy has been an active BCAM member since 1976. She served on the Board of Directors from 1990 through 2000 and was BCAM president in 1992. She was chairman of the Miss Basketball committee for many years. Kathy served WBCA on the Board of Directors from 1990-1996. She was also the Chairman of the Selection Committee for the Kodak High School All-American team in 1991-1992. Kathy has been Michigan's Class A or B Coach of the Year 4 times. She has been BCAM's Overall State Coach of the Year 3 times and was the WBCA runner-up for National Coach of the Year in 1997. She also served as Assistant Coach in the World Youth Games in 1998.

This summer, Kathy McGee was named National High School Coach of the Year by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association and the National Federation Coaches Association.
