



2013 BCAM College Coaches of the Year

Kevin Vande Streek – Calvin College Men’s College Coach of the Year

This past season Coach Vande Streek was named the Division III Great Lakes Co-District Coach of the Year by the National Association of Basketball Coaches. Coach Vande Streek led Calvin to its third MIAA regular season title in five years and its first MIAA Tournament crown since 2007. He also led Calvin to its first NCAA III Tournament berth since 2007 as the Knights advanced to the Round of 16 of the NCAA III Tournament. Calvin concluded the year with an overall record of 26-4.

Steve Proefrock – Glen Oaks Community College Men’s Junior College Coach of the Year

In his 16th season at Glen Oaks Community College, Coach Proefrock led his team to the Western Conference Championship with a conference season record 15-1 and an overall record of 27-4. Their only conference loss was a 105-103 OT loss to GRCC.

Carrie Lohr – Wayne State University Women’s College Coach of the Year

Coach Lohr led her team to a 22-9 record, a GLIAC North regular season championship and the first NCAA Tournament win in school history. After a 2011-12 season in which the team finished with a record of 12-14, the warriors had one of the most successful seasons in program history.

Michael Groulx – St. Clair County Community College Women’s Junior College Coach of the Year

Coach Groulx took a 9-9 team from a year ago and led them to the Eastern Conference Championship. The Skippers finished the 2012-13 season with a 32-3 overall record and a fourth place finish in the NJCAA DIII national tournament.
