

2013 BCAM MEN'S COLLEGE ACADEMIC – ATHLETIC TEAM

Each BCAM Honor Team pays tribute to five outstanding scholar-athletes from Michigan colleges and universities at the NCAA I, NCAA II, NCAA III, and NAIA levels. To be eligible, players have to be either a starter or an important reserve and have at least a 3.2 grade point average. The BCAM teams are selected on the basis of academic achievement, athletic accomplishments, grade point average and their coach's BCAM membership.

Jr Derek Billing Lake Superior State Univ. 3.58 Anna, OH

Derek was an All-GLIAC Second Team selection this year while averaging 15.2 ppg. Twice he was selected as the GLIAC Player of the Week. He was also selected to the 2013 Capitol One Academic All-District IX Team. He has a 3.58 GPA and is majoring in Exercise Science.

Jr Travis Bader Oakland University 3.45 Okemos, MI

Travis led the country with a school and Summit League record 139 three point field goals. An All-Summit League first team selection, he averaged 22.1 ppg. Bader graduated from Oakland in three years with a 3.45 in Communications and is currently working on his master's degree.

Jr Mark Ghafari Kalamazoo College 3.78 Grosse Pte Shores, MI

Mark is a 1st team All-MIAA selection as well as a two year team captain. This past season he was voted team MVP and the Best Teammate by his team. He was also selected to the Academic All-American – 3rd Team. Mark has a cumulative GPA of 3.78 in Economics.

Jr Brandon Krause Alma College 3.76 Midland, MI

Brandon was an All-MIAA 2nd Team selection this season and was voted his team's MVP. He averages 10.5 ppg and was selected as a MIAA Player of the Week. He finished in the Top Ten in four different MIAA statistical categories. He has a cumulative GPA of 3.76 in Math and Business.

Sr Brett Beland Saginaw Valley State Univ. 3.58 Menominee, MI

Brett was 4th in the nation in Free Throw Percentage in 2011-12. This past season he averaged 13.0 points per game connecting on 60 three point field goals. Named to the SVSU Dean's every semester of his career; and a four-time member of the GLIAC All-Academic Excellence Team. Brett has a cumulative GPA of 3.58 in Marketing and Management.
