

2017 BCAM Men's and Women's College Academic / Athletic Teams

Sr. Harrison Blackledge Hope College 3.91 North Canton, OH
 This past season Harrison was 1st Team NABC All-American, CoSIDA Academic All-American and the Josten's Award Winner (National Student/Athlete of the Year in DIII). He was the MIAA MVP as well as 1st Team All-MIAA for the second time. He led his team to the DIII Sweet 16 this year. Harrison has a 3.91 GPA with a double major of Marketing and Communications.

Sr. Jared Bradford Grace Bible College 3.55 Sparta, MI
 Jared was a finalist for the Maravich Award, the NCCAA's highest award for athletics, academics, character, and community service. During his senior season, Jared broke the school record for 3's in a game (11), 3's in a season (106), and 3's in a career (288). He was named NCCAA II 1st Team All Region 2015, 16 & 17, 1st Team All American 2016 & 17, National Tournament All-Tournament Team 2016 & 17. In 2017 he led the NCCAA in FT with 90.8%. He has a 3.55 GPA in Business Administration and Marketing.

Sr. Sherron Dorsey-Walker Oakland University 3.36 Detroit, MI
 Sherron is a three-time Horizon League Academic Honor Roll selection and is just the second player in program history to be named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team in the Division I era. He is a 2016-17 Academic All-League Selection. Ranked among the league's best in scoring (13th), rebounds (T18th) and assists (8th)... Dorsey-Walker made a career-best eight triples in the regular season finale to clinch a first-ever regular season championship. He has a 3.36 GPA in Pre-Integrative Studies.

Sr. Kevin Rich Davenport University 3.96 Grand Rapids, MI
 Kevin is a 2nd Team NAIA All-American, Daktronics NAIA Scholar-Athlete, CoSIDA 1st Team Academic All-American, 1st Team All-Conference, and a member of the WHAC All-Academic Team. He became the 5th player in school history to surpass 1,500 career points, finishing with 1,765 career points. Kevin is DU's team leading 3-point scorer and finished his career with 278 made threes. Rich is tied for first in most games played in a career with 143, and first in total minutes played in a career with 4,150. He will graduate with a Masters of Accountancy and carries a 3.96 GPA.

Sr. Luke Ryskamp Grand Valley State University 3.40 Schoolcraft, MI
 For the past three seasons Luke has been selected to the GLIAC All-Academic Team. He led GVSU in scoring the past two seasons and finished his career with 1,313 points. Luke is a two-time All-GLIAC selection and is a three-time winner of GVSU's Offensive Player of the Year Award. Luke has earned a 3.4 GPA in Occupational Safety/Health Management.

So. Reyna Frost Central Michigan University 3.89 Reese, MI
 This season, the CMU Chippewas won their first MAC regular-season championship since 1985. Reyna Frost is a member of that 2017 MAC Championship team—averaging 31 minutes per game. Her impact on the court earned her third team All-MAC and MAC West Player of the Week (12/27/16). Additionally, she finished the season ranked 6th in the country in rebounding. In the classroom, Reyna joined five of her CMU teammates on the Academic All-Mid-American Conference (the most in program history). Reyna has a 3.89 GPA (she earned a 4.0 in Fall 2016) while majoring in Physics/Astronomy.

Jr. Taylor Gleason Oakland University 3.88 Grand Blanc, MI
 Oakland University women's basketball member Taylor Gleason currently holds a 3.88 GPA as an Exercise Science major. She has earned herself a spot on the 2017 Horizon League women's basketball Academic All-League Team. Taylor started 28 of 30 games this season for OU. She led the Grizzlies in three-pointers (46), was second in scoring (11.7 ppg) and fourth in steals per game (2.1). Gleason, the team captain, helped the Grizzlies finish the regular season tied for third with a 12-6 Horizon League record (18-11 overall), the program's best league finish since its inaugural season in 2013-14.

Sr. Anna Timmer Calvin College 3.79 Caledonia, MI
 Senior Anna Timmer has had an impressive career at Calvin College, both on and off the court. The 3.79 Kinesiology major set the new WBB Calvin College single-season rebounding record with 320. She is the 3rd all-time leading rebounder at Calvin with 785 and 7th on the career scoring list with 1,274 points. This season she earned 1st team All-MIAA, 3rd team Great Lakes All-Region Team 2017 D3 Hoops. Anna led the MIAA league in rebounding (11.4 rpg). Her 19 double-doubles this season placed her among the top 10 in the country in her division. She is a three-time MIAA Academic Honor Roll selection and a 2017 member of the D3 CoSIDA Academic All-District team.

Sr. Kylie Townsley Spring Arbor University 3.92 Macomb, MI
 Spring Arbor senior, Kylie Townsley, has demonstrated a notable work ethic on the court and in the classroom. She holds a 3.92 GPA as a Health & Exercise Science/Psychology major. She is 4th on SAU's all-time scoring list, notching 1,403 points in her career. Townsley is a two-time Daktronics-NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Scholar-Athlete. She was also selected for the NAIA/ American Red Cross Leadership Program. This season she also received All-Crossroads League 2nd team Honors.

Sr. Emily Wendling Saginaw Valley State 3.94 Flushing, MI
 Saginaw Valley State University senior, Emily Wendling, dominated in her last season both on and off the court. She is SVSU's all-time leading scorer with 1,973 points, and pulled down 995 rebounds in her career. She was 2nd in the GLIAC in scoring and FT percentage, while also clinching the 5th spot for rebounding. Wendling received her second CoSIDA Academic All-American honor, while also being named a GLIAC Winter Commissioner's Award recipient. She currently holds a 3.94 GPA as an Occupational Therapy major.

Each BCAM Honor Team pays tribute to five outstanding scholar-athletes from Michigan colleges and universities at the NCAA I, NCAA II, NCAA III, and NAIA levels. To be eligible, players have to be either a starter or an important reserve, must have reached sophomore standing, have participated in at least 50% of the team's games, and have at least a 3.0 GPA. The BCAM teams are selected on the basis of academic achievement, athletic accomplishments, GPA and their coach's BCAM membership.
