George made three stops in his coaching career. The first was from 1957-1963 at Fowler where he had been Captain of the 1952 State Champions. His coaching record was 104 wins and 25 losses. Included were 6 League Championships, 6 District, and 5 Regionals.

He then moved to Lansing O'Rafferty High School (1963-68) and posted a record of 58 wins and 38 losses. Included were 2 League, 1 District and 1 Regional Championship.

In 1970 he took over at Lansing Everett and remained until 1979. His teams won 143 and lost 61 over this span. Included were 5 League, 5 District, 4 Regional and the Class "A" State Title in 1977.

George was the AP & UPI Coach of the Year in 1976 and 1977. He is a member of the Greater Lansing Hall of Fame and is the only person to ever coach and play on a High School State Championship Team in Michigan.
