

2022 BCAM MEN'S COLLEGE ACADEMIC-ATHLETIC TEAM

Sr. Owen White Michigan Tech University 3.82 Rhinelander, WI

After averaging 17.6 pts and 6 rebounds per game this past season Owen was GLIAC Player of the Year. This was his second straight GLIAC Player of the Year honor. He also was 1st Team NABC All-Region for the second time. He led Michigan Tech to a regular season conference co-Championship. Has been a member of SAAC, team captain and leader of athletic bible study on campus. Owen has a 3.82 GPA in Mechanical Engineering.

Sr. Justin Fischer Lake Superior State University 3.59 Sterling Heights, MI

Justin has been a 3-year starter and team leader for LSSU. He has been one of the top assist leaders in the GLIAC every year. His strong all-around play made him one his team's best defenders and rebounders as well. He finishes his career ranked as 11th all time in assists at LSSU. Justin has a 3.59 GPA in Business Administration-Management.

Sr. Dorian Aluyi Ferris State University 3.85 Chicago, IL
