

2022 BCAM WOMEN'S COLLEGE ACADEMIC-ATHLETIC TEAM

So. Gracie Nowak Mid-Michigan College Education 3.92 Morrice, MI

Mid-Michigan College sophomore women's basketball member Gracie Nowak currently holds a 3.92 GPA as an Education major. She earned a spot on the 2022 Michigan Community College Athletic Association (MCCAA) All-West Third Team. In addition, her defensive efforts earned her a spot on the 2022 MCCAA All-Defensive team. Nowak led the Lakers this season in total steals (71), rebounding (7.2 rpg), and assists (87), all while averaging 8.3 points per game. Her contributions helped her team conclude a 20-win season and clinch a berth in the NJCAA Great Lakes District A Tournament.

Gr. Ellie Taylor Northwood University Business Administration 4.00 Midland, MI

Graduate student Ellie Taylor has had impressive career at Northwood University; both on and off the court. The 4.0 student athlete pursuing a Master of Business Administration entered the NU history books as she concluded her career with 1,084 points, which is good for 16th in program history. Her 163 career 3-point field goals made stands fourth at Northwood. During Ellie's final collegiate year, she averaged 12.8 points, 4.8 rebounds and 2.9 assists. She was awarded a spot on the 2022 All-GLIAC second team. Taylor has been named to the GLIAC All-Academic Excellence team (2018-19, 19-20, 20-21, 21-22).

Sr. Gabrielle Timmer Calvin College Health & Physical Education 3.55 Caledonia, MI

Calvin senior Gabrielle Timmer had a standout senior campaign, averaging 18.7 points, 10.2 rebounds and 2.4 blocked shots a game while connecting on 55.8 percent of her field goal attempts. She notched 15 double-doubles during the season and was a three-time MIAA Player of the Week. She also landed a spot on the All-MIAA First Team for the third time in four years. Timmer moved into third place on the Calvin career scoring list, boosting her total to 1,553 points. She also moved into third place on the Calvin career rebounding list (879) and fifth in career blocked shots (153). In March of 2022 Timmer was named, for a second time, to the D3hoops.com All-Region 7 Second Team. She also won this award as a collegiate freshman at Calvin College in 2019.

Sr. Grace Touchette Hillsdale College Economics 3.79 Northfield, MN

A four-year member and 3-year starter the Hillsdale College women's basketball team, Grace Touchette is an accomplished student-athlete. During the 21-22 campaign Grace became a member of the Hillsdale Chargers 1,000-point club (1225 total points). After four years in the blue and white Touchette's shooting percentage is 42% field goal, 34% 3pt field goal and 74% from free throw. She earned a spot on the 2021-22 1st Team All-Great Midwest Athletic Conference. Touchette has been a standout in the classroom during her time at Hillsdale. She has made the Dean's List every semester of college and earned Academic All-G-MAC honors all four years of her career. A two year team captain, she has participated as a member of the Hillsdale Student-Athlete Advisory Council.

So. Megan Wagner Western Michigan University Integrated Supply Management 4.00 Mason, OH

Western Michigan University sophomore Megan Wagner has demonstrated a notable work ethic on the court and in the classroom. According to WMU head coach Shane Clipfell, "Megan has been a great ambassador for our program since stepping onto campus. She represents what student-athletes should be from top to bottom." Wagner and nine of her Bronco teammates earned 2021 Academic All-Mid-American Conference (MAC) honors, which ranks first across the conference this season. On the court, Megan guided the offense with 99 season assists. She was among the top 10 in assist to turnover ratio this season among all Mid-American conference female players.
